ELIGIBLE POST HIGH SCHOOL INSTITUTIONS:

- Applicant will be enrolled in a post-high school institution.
- Post-high school institutions include four year universities, two-year colleges and vocationaltechnical schools in fields like construction, mechanics, welding, flight school, culinary arts, etc.

EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior or have achieved a GED at an accredited institution. This includes Anchorage School District high schools, as well as the State of Alaska/Municipality of Anchorage charter and home schools.
- A GED qualifies as graduating. Students who have taken a gap year and are returning to higher education (20 years of age or under) are enouraged to apply.
- Applicant must have attended the Girdwood K-8 School (or elementary grade and middle school home school equivalent) and been based full time in the Four Valleys for the last 5 years.

COMMUNITY SERVICE:

- Applicant must demonstrate prior involvement in community service activities and projects through helping individuals and community groups. in the Four Valley's and Anchorage.
- It is helpful to have volunteered regularly for FVCS and Lions Club events, as well as other community events and services such as Forest Fair, Community Thanksgiving, Food Pantry, etc.

APPLICATION:

Applicants must submit a scholarship folder containing:

- Completed application form.
- Biographical sketch including personal history, special interests, description of community involvement and volunteer service, plus ambitions and future educational plans (approx. 450-500 words).
- Evidence of involvement in community service activities by including signed volunteer hours letters signed by the community organizations, and a short explaination of project(s). Photo's can also help demonstrate this.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation written and signed. Acceptable sources include teachers, guidance counselors, project leaders and other adults.
- Current high school transcript as evidence of tracking to complete high school program (GED and home school students included).

FOUR VALLEYS RESIDENCY:

- Applicant must be a full-time resident of the Four Valleys area (Bird Creek, Girdwood, Indian or Portage) for the last 5 years.
- Applicant must be able to demonstrate full time residency in Bird Creek, Indian, Girdwood, or Portage for the past 5 years.
- Applicant must be a United States citizen.
